

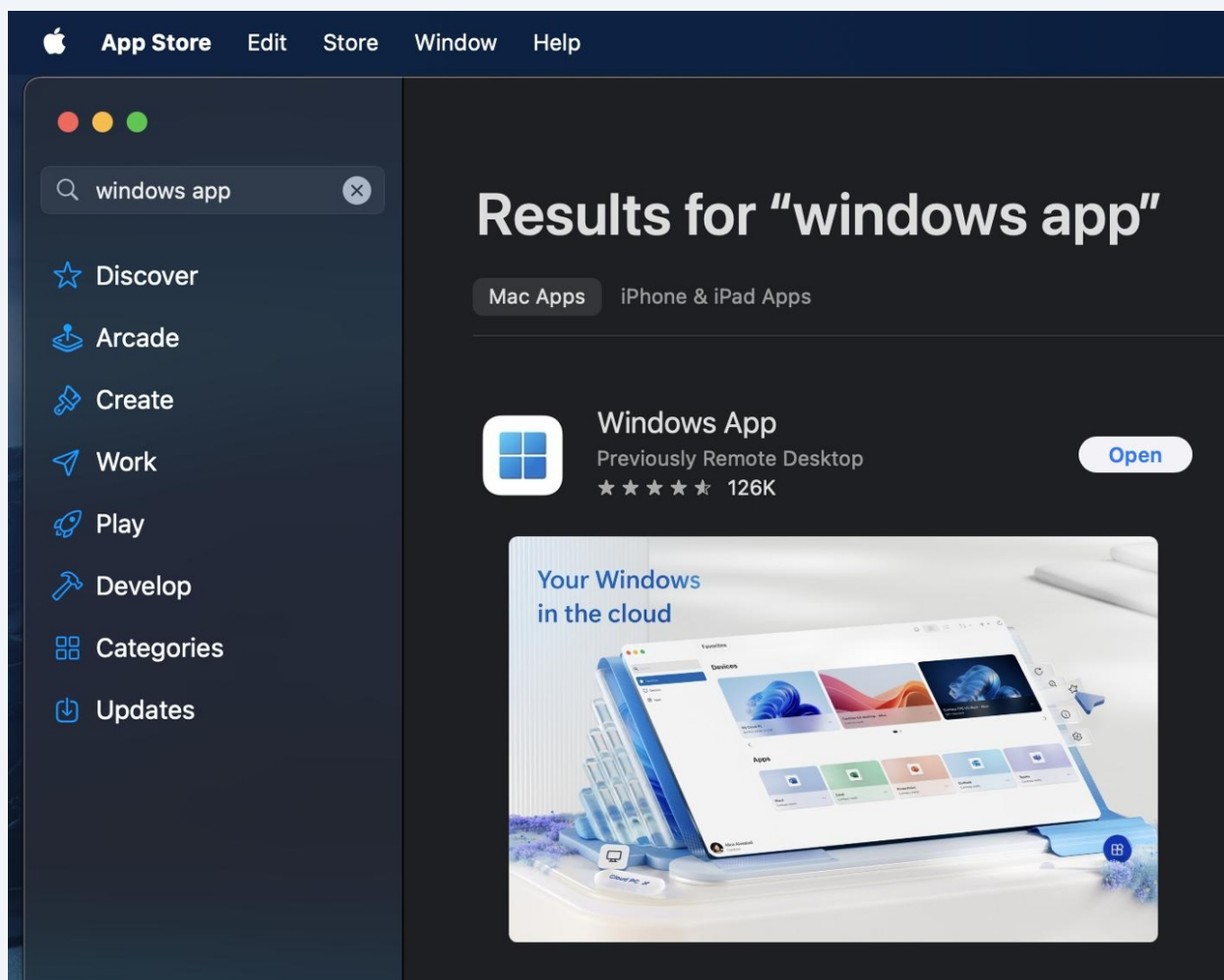
Everest Quick Guide: Installing Everest Desktop with 'Windows App' on Mac



How to setup the Everest Desktop Application using the 'Windows App' on a Mac.

- 1 Download and install the 'Windows App' from the Mac App Store:

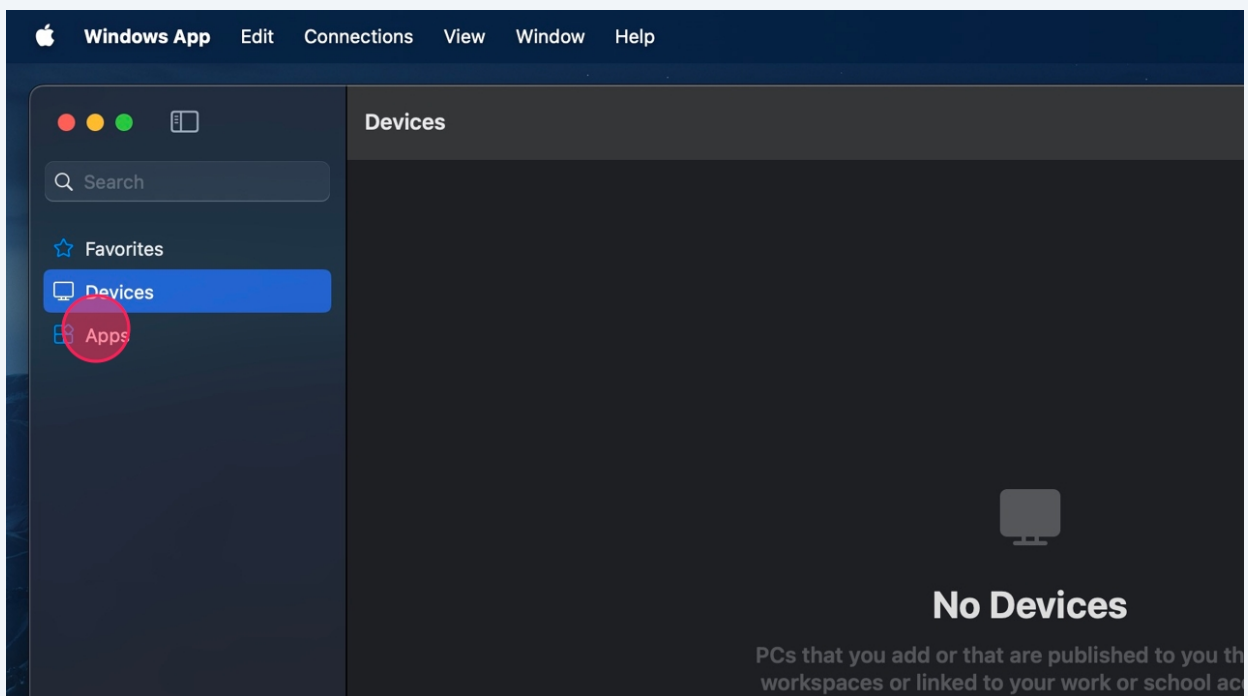

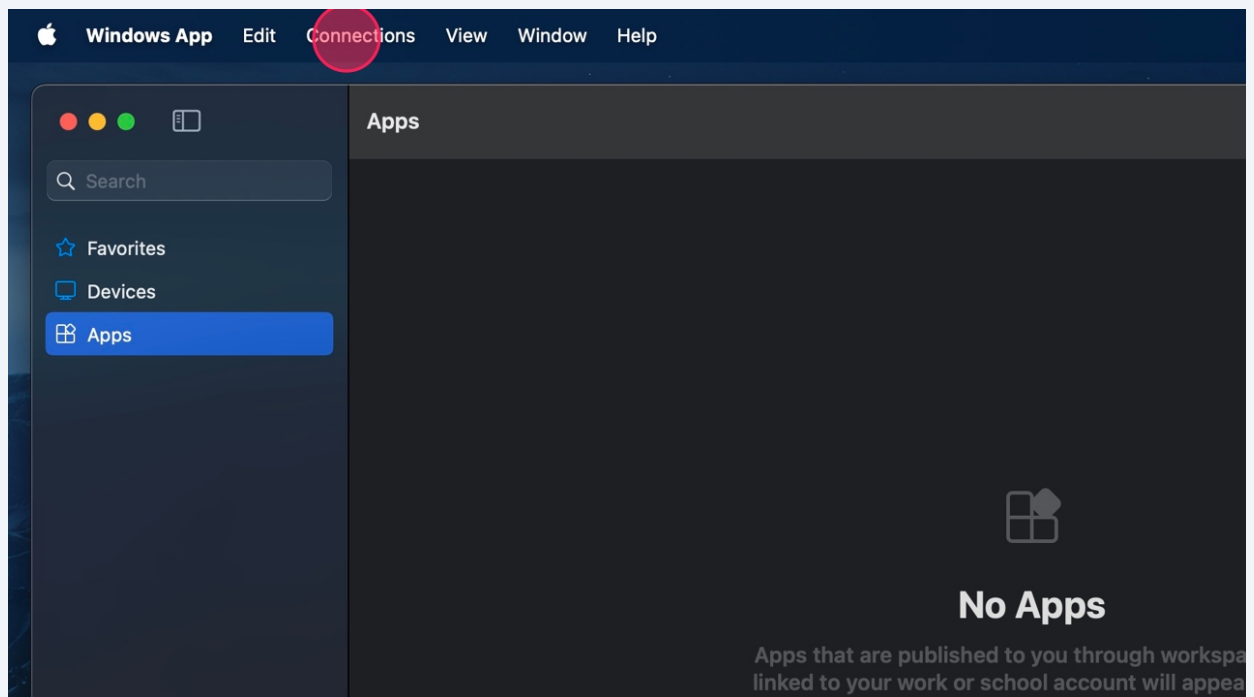
2 Open the Windows App



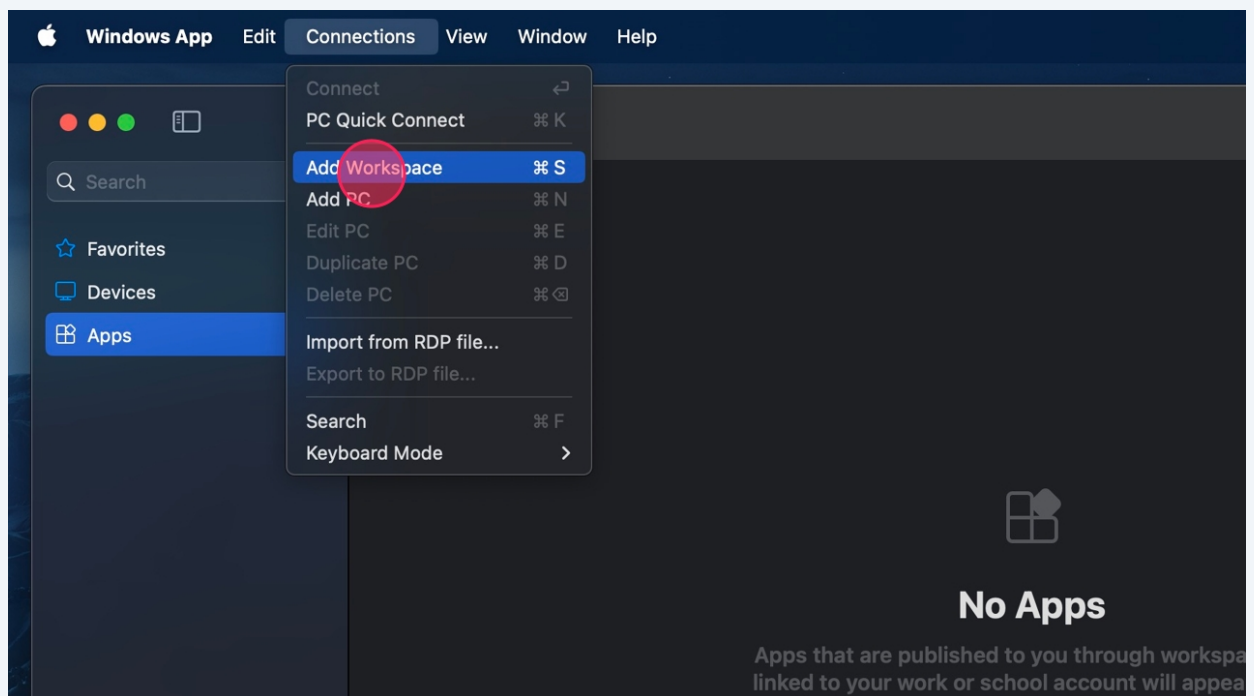
3 Click the Apps button



4 Click "Connections"

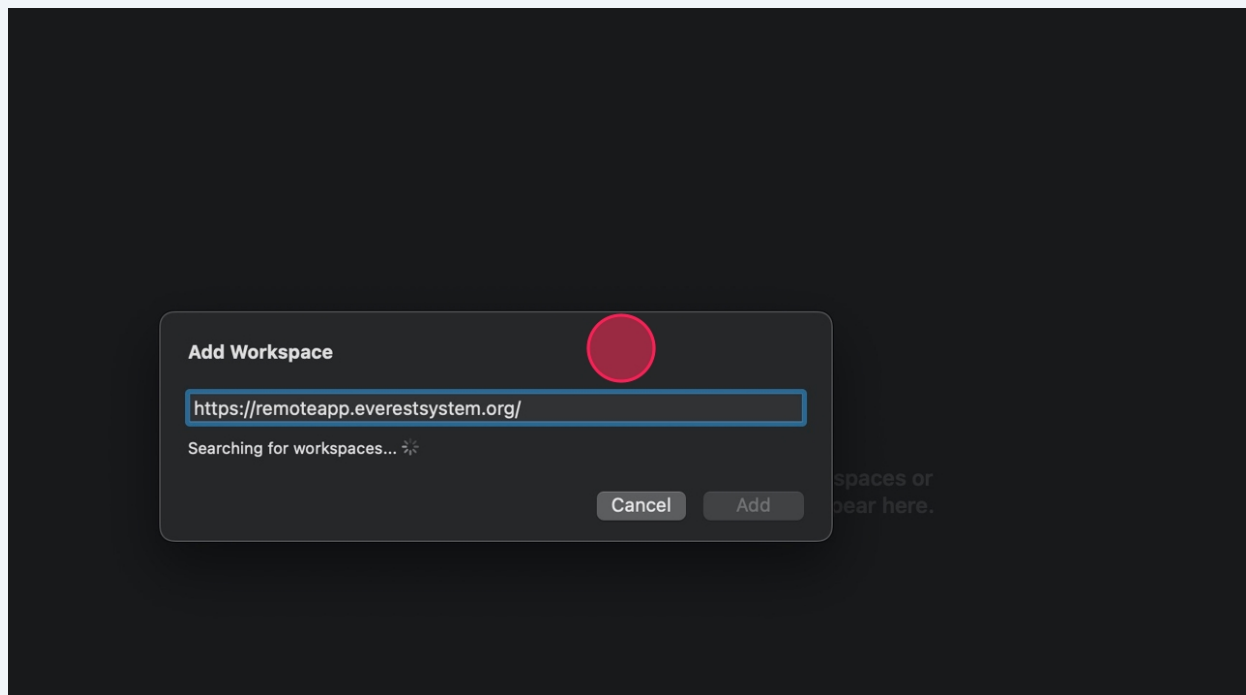


5 Click "Add Workspace"

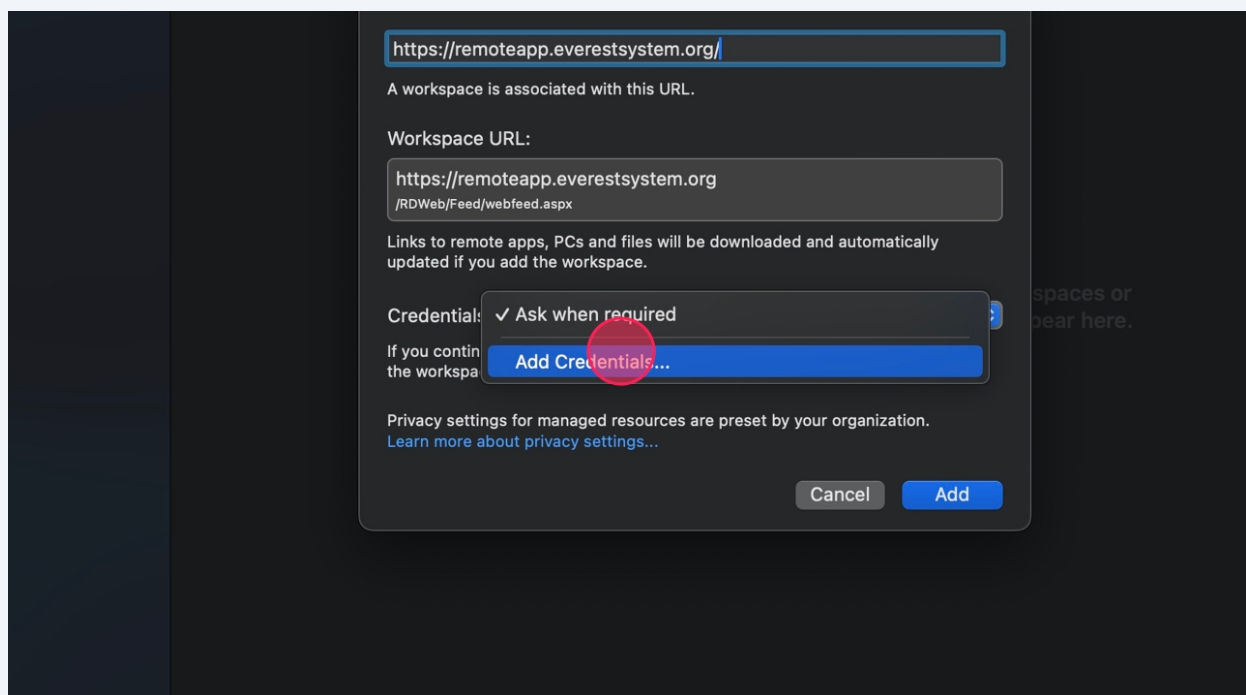


6 In "Add Workspace", paste in this URL:

<https://remoteapp.everestsystem.org/>

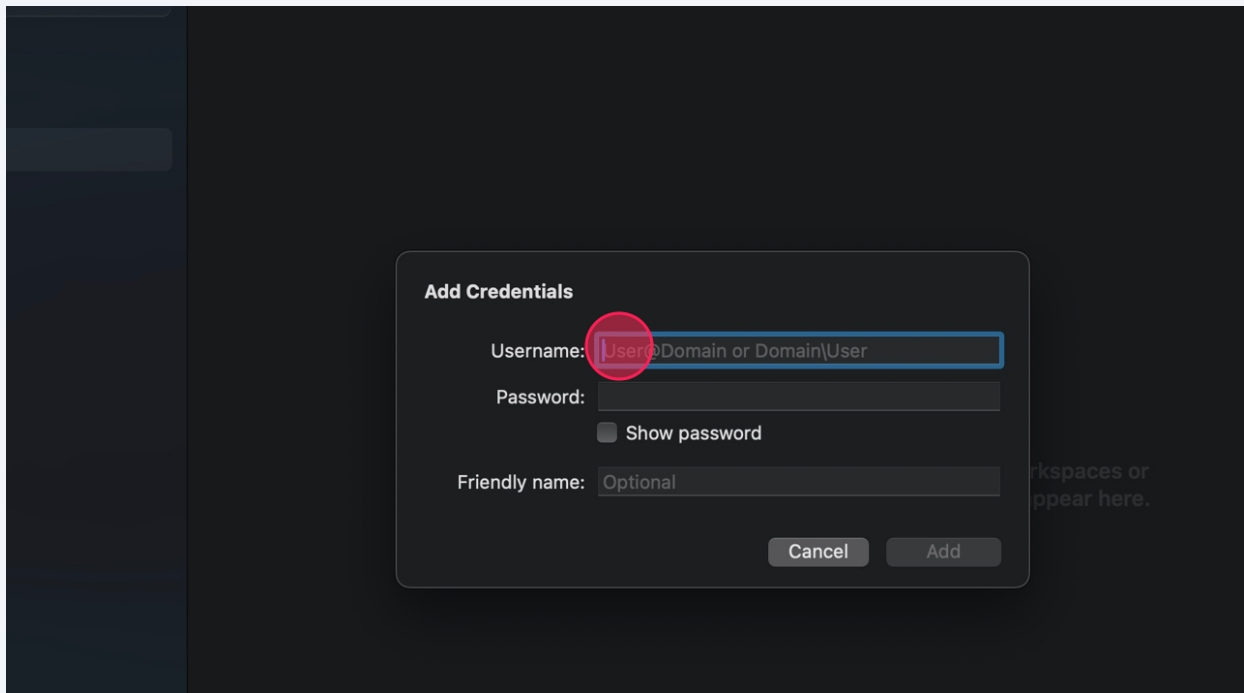


7 In Credentials, click "Add Credentials..."

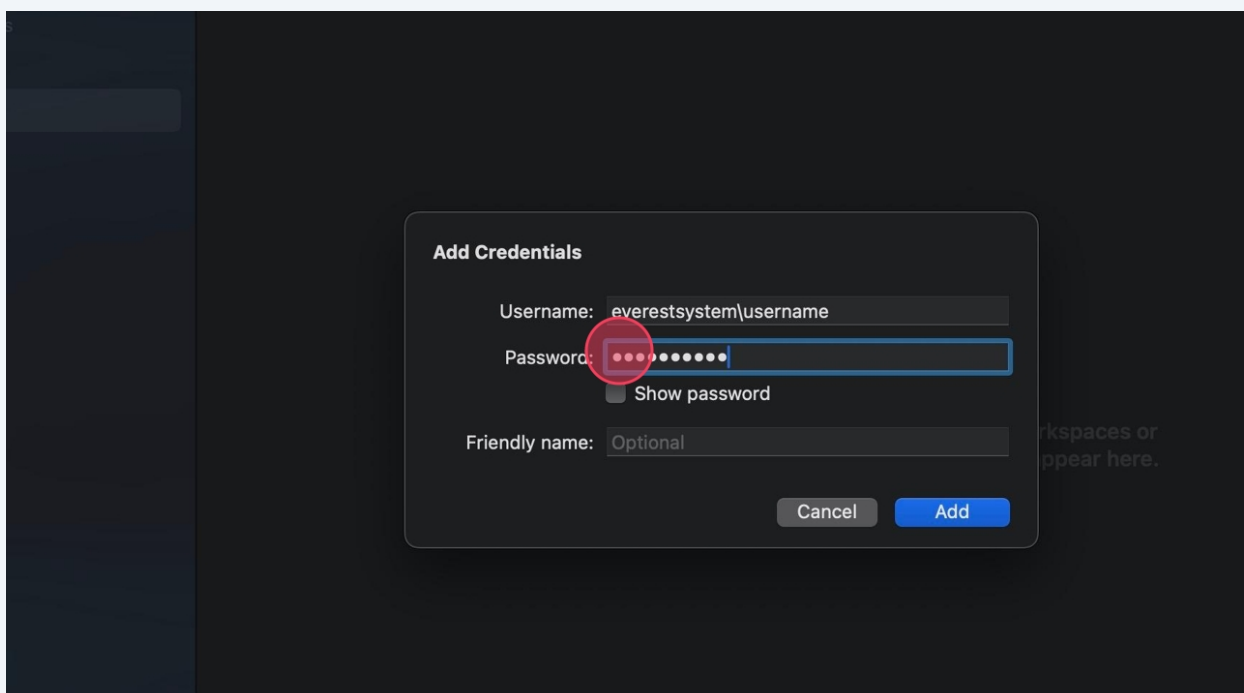


- 8 In the Username text field, type in your **Everest Username** in this format:


everestsystem\username



- 9 In the Password text field, type in your **Everest Password**




10 In the Friendly name text field, type in **Everest**

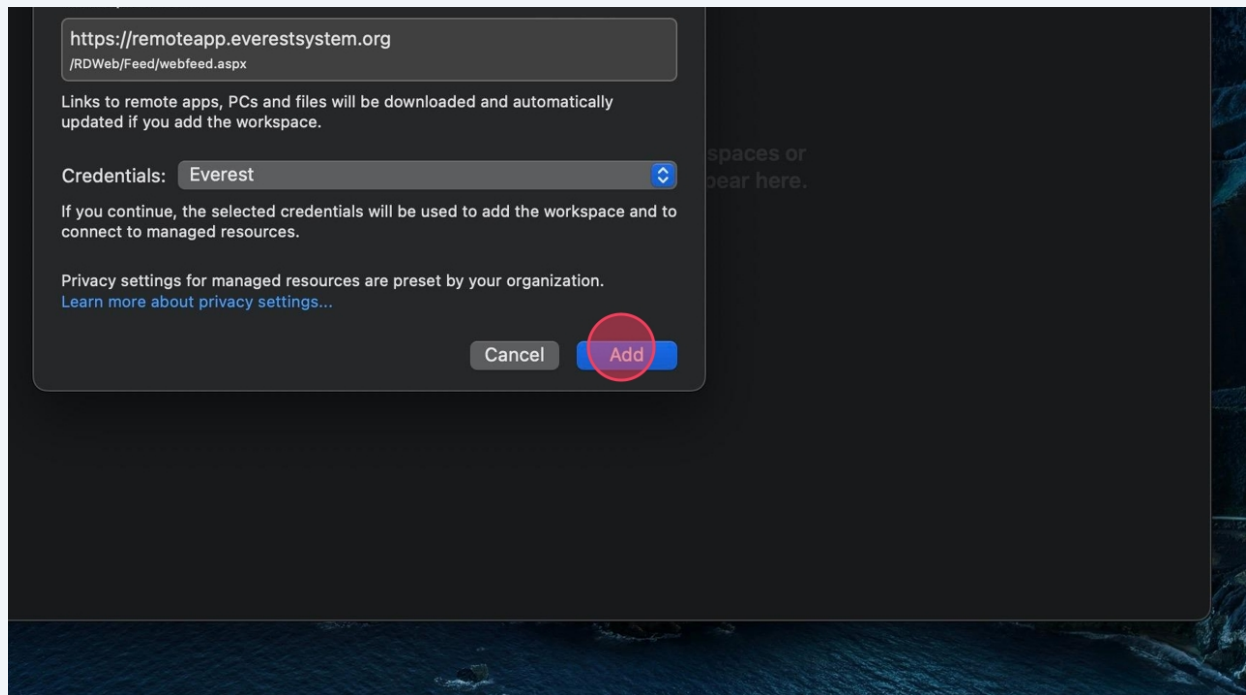
11 Click "Add"

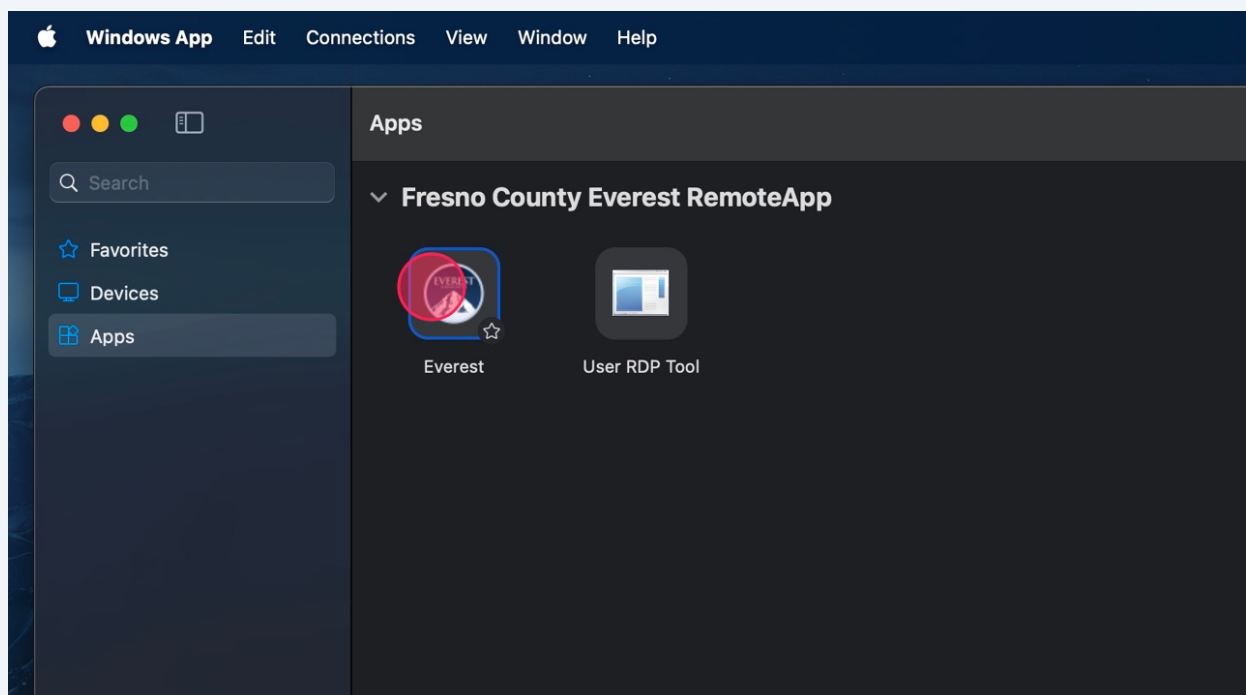
